Since 1983 he has been performing on stage. First as one of the driving forces in the band The Ex(1983-2002) and later with his own groups including ROOF (w/ Tom Cora); 4Walls (w/ Phil Minton)) and SOL6 & SOL12.

He worked in various collaborations including the belgian absurdist <u>Kamagurka</u>, Franz Hautzingers <u>Regenorchestra</u> (W/ Christina Fennesz & Otomo Yoshihide) and singers <u>Sidsel Endresen</u>. (<u>Speeq</u>) and <u>Isabelle Duthoit</u> (<u>Bouge</u>)

Recent he runs and writes for 3 different groups, all with their own 'signature'. There is the adventurous music of <u>Naked Wolf</u> (w/ Yedo Gibson, Mika szafirowski, Felicty Provan and Gerri Jager); his interpretation of a jazz quartet with <u>Luc Ex' Assemblee</u> (w/ Hamid Drake, Ingrid Laubrock, Ab Baars) and the comemporary blues of Rubatong (w/ Han Buhrs, René v. Barnenveld & Tatiana Koleva).

Maybe different styles but at the end they all the same thing in common: 'typical Luc Ex music', which means sincere, original, energetic and touching.

The last years he has been concentrating more and more on composing and has recently found a way to combine this with his fascination for sounds. Where does the one stops and where does the other start. It will always be an arbitrary choice.

This have lead to the project and ensemble **Music Of Inevitable Sounds** and his new project **Objet Sonore**. It revolves around a monumental loudspeaker designed for public spaces and will play a special compositions build of city-sounds.
